Liceo Malpighi, with its 420 pupils, has a very long and established history. It is located in the medieval city of Bologna, where the first University in the world was founded in 1088.

In our school there are three programmes of studies:

LICEO SCIENTIFICO

The curriculum has been created with the intent of forming students who are able to easily orient themselves within scientific studies, with an emphasis on international contexts.

LICEO SCIENZE APPLICATE

The objective of the curriculum is to create students who are able to easily orient themselves within science-related subjects and to understand the possible areas where they can apply these skills.

LICEO LINGUISTICO

The study of four foreign languages (Mandarin, French, Spanish, German), linked with a finely tuned study of the humanities, helps to acquire a mastery of language and opens the mind to diverse cultures – a precious tool in any future endeavor.

Our peculiarities

LESSONS IN THE LABORATORIES

The daily use of the laboratories allows for a gradual acquisition of typical research methods used in scientific disciplines.

In addition to school activities, there are additional lessons in external laboratories such as *Scienza in pratica* all'Opificio Golinelli, *Fisica in moto* in Ducati, and with special projects such as the competition *Mouse TrapCar Grand Prix*.

DIGITAL SKILLS CREATIVITY AND INNOVATION

During the whole five-year period, and transversely to all subjects, great attention is devoted to the acquisition of digital skills which are nowadays necessary to tackle all areas of study.

The Malpighi La.B is a place available to all students where they can increase their creative and planning skills in three main areas: IT, Robotics and Automation, Design/3D Planning.

ENGLISH AT MALPIGHI: A FOUR-LEVEL APPROACH TO TEACHING AND A NETWORK OF INTERNATIONAL SCHOOLS

English teaching is based on a four-level approach, in other words students are divided into four homogenous groups in terms of language skills.

All students reach level B2 of the European Framework, certified by the Cambridge Exam of the First Certificate in English (FCE). Advanced students reach level C1.

In addition, within the first two years of the Secondary School, subjects, or parts of subjects, are taught in English.

Finally, during the fourth year, students have the chance to spend a period of study abroad, in select schools with a direct connection with Malpighi (USA, UK, Canada, Australia).

SAT OR IELTS

Fourth year advanced students can choose to prepare the SAT (English, Critical Thinking, Math), which is required to access American Universities and recognized worldwide, or the IELTS (an English Test which is required for those who aim at studying or working in English-speaking countries, in particular in the UK and Australia).
